The learned APP on instructions of PSI Mr. G B Ganeshkar of Narpoli Police Station, Thane, who is present in Court, submits that Senior Police Inspector of Narpoli Police Station, Thane shall take a decision on the application/complaint submitted by the Petitioner within a period of one week from today. Statement accepted.
