2. The Petitioner seeks a Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of one Arvind Bhimsen Desai, who is said to have died intestate in Mumbai, where he was ordinarily resident, on 18th November 1997. A copy of his death certificate is annexed.
