1. Pursuant to the direction issued on 20th October, 2021 extension of time granted for compliance vide order dated 30th November, 2021. The learned counsel for the plaintiff states that poundage due to the Sheriff has been duly paid and he seeks leave to withdraw the Execution Application and accordingly he submits

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that the attachment may be raised.

2. The learned counsel for the plaintiff-decree holder points out that there are six chamber summons listed in the cause title all of which seek raising of attachment.
3. In view of the withdrawal of the Execution Application, the learned counsel submits that the attachment may be raised since he has received the entire decretal sum decreed to marked satisfied. Accordingly, Chamber Summons no.795 of 2010 is allowed in terms of prayer clauses (a) and (b).
