- (iii) Parties to appear before the Sole Arbitrator on a date to be fixed by him per his earliest convenience.
- (iv) Fees payable to the Sole Arbitrator will be in accordance with the Bombay High Court (Fee Payable to Arbitrators) Rules, 2018.
- (v) Arbitration Petition is disposed in the above terms.
