1. We have heard this matter for some time. Shri Deshpande, learned counsel for the petitioner, upon instructions, seeks leave of the Court to withdraw the petition with a prayer for directing the trial Court to expeditiously dispose of the criminal proceedings on merit and if required after separating the trial of the petitioner from that of the co-accused of the petitioner.
