Hearing was conducted through Video Conferencing and the learned counsel agreed that the audio and visual quality was proper.

By this appeal, the appellants challenge the impugned order passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Akola below Exh.1 thereby rejecting Regular Bail Application of the appellants in Crime No.15/2021 registered with Police Station Channi, Tahsil-Patur, District-Akola for offences under sections 324, 504, 506 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 3 (1) (r), 3(1) (s), 3 (2) (va) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

The second respondent lodged FIR alleging that the appellants assaulted him with sticks and had intentionally insulted him and abused him in the name of caste with an intention to humiliate him as a member of scheduled caste.

The appellants were arrested on 18.1.2021 and after rejection of their regular bail application, preferred this appeal. This court, vide order dated 2.2.2021, released the appellants on interim bail.

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on instructions, makes a statement that on 8.3.2021, the chargesheet filed against the appellants and the case is numbered as C.C. No.63/2021 in the Special Court, Akola.

Since the investigation is complete, custodial detention of the appellants is not necessary, hence the Criminal Appeal is allowed and disposed of by confirming the interim bail order passed in favour of the appellants on 2.2.2021.
