1. Heard.

2. Rule. Rule made returnable forthwith. Heard finally by consent of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor, who appears by waiving

notice for the respondents.

The petitioner's application for grant of Covid-19 parole in terms of the G.R. dated 08.05.2020 has been rejected on the ground that on the last occasion, the petitioner had surrendered before the jail authorities by a delay of 38 days. It is one of the conditions of the G.R. dated 08.05.2020 that on the last two occasions when the petitioner was released, the petitioner must not have reported back to the jail authorities with any delay. In the present case, admittedly, the petitioner had surrendered after a delay of about 38 days and that was the last time when he committed such misconduct. So, the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the prohibitions contained in the G.R dated 08.05.2020 and as such nothing wrong could be noticed in the impugned order. The Writ Petition is dismissed.
