This is an appeal under Section 14-A of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 seeking bail, since appellant is arrested in connection with Crime No.352 of 2020 dated 05.06.2020 registered with Police Station, Katol, District Nagpur for the offences punishable under Sections 109, 201, 313, 315, 316, 318, 506, 376(2)(d), 376(2)(f), 376(2)(j), 376(2)(l), 376(2)(n) and 376(3) of the Indian Penal Code, under Sections 4, 6, 17 and 21 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, under Sections 3(1)(w)(i) (ii), 3(2)(v) and 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act and under Sections 92(b), 92(d) and 92(f) of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act.

(2) Along with this appeal, entire charge-sheet is also

placed on record. After hearing the learned counsel for the appellant Shri Rohit Joshi and learned Additional Public Prosecutor Shri T.A. Mirza and after perusing the charge-sheet and reply, when the Court was about to dismiss the appeal, learned counsel for the appellant submits that he be permitted to withdraw this appeal.

(3) His prayer is accepted.

(4) The appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.

(5) Since the learned counsel for the appellant is withdrawing this appeal, the Court is not giving detailed reasons for its dismissal.
