The applicant has filed a writ petition before this Court against the non-applicant. When the writ petition was on a stamp, for non-removal of office objections the Registrar (Judicial) passed the order dated 05.01.2015 rejecting the writ petition. Against that, an application for restoration is filed. Since it was barred by limitation, an application for condonation of delay is also filed.
