2. This Contempt Petition can be disposed of is the submission made by Shri Deshpande, learned counsel for the contempt petitioner. He invited attention to the order dated 14/10/2021, passed by this Court (Coram : Avinash G. Gharote, J.). By the said order, the learned Assistant Government Pleader was permitted to deposit the amount of compensation in the Court and accordingly, the amount is

deposited with this Court. By the said order itself, the contempt petitioner was permitted to withdraw the amount of compensation.

3. Since the contemnor has purged the contempt by depositing amount of compensation in this Court, nothing survives in this contempt petition and it is disposed of as such with liberty to the petitioner to withdraw the amount deposited in this Court, with accrued interest.
