2. The Petitioner has challenged the order dated 13 April, 2020 and has prayed that the petitioner's appeal filed in respect of his Certificate of Medical Fitness be allowed.

3. The Petitioner has filed a rejoinder annexing a copy of the order dated 5 November 2020 in Writ Petition No. 2238 of 2020 passed

by the Division Bench of this Court.
