2. This is an application for condonation of delay of 240 days in bringing the legal heirs of appellant no.3 on record.

3. Learned counsel for the appellants submits that sufficient reason has been shown in the application more particularly in paragraphs 2 and 3. It is further submitted that the delay was bonafide and not intentional.
