Heard Shri Shende, learned counsel for the applicants, Smt. Barabde, learned Assistant Government Pleader for non-applicant nos.1 and 2 and Shri Parsodkar, learned counsel for non-applicant no.3.

(2) This is an application for condonation of delay in filing the revision for setting aside the order passed by the Registrar (Judicial) dated 17.10.2016.

(3) The application is filed on affidavit. The affidavit is given by Advocate Prashant Namdeo Shende. After having gone through the contents of the statements of facts made on the affidavit, I am satisfied that the applicants have made out a case for condonation of delay. Hence, the application for condonation of delay is allowed and disposed of accordingly. The delay is condoned.
