Mr. Tejas Patil, learned counsel for the appellant, submitted that the appeal was filed challenging the judgment and order passed by the learned Ad hoc Additional Sessions Judge-1, Yavatmal, in Sessions Trial No.43 of 2013, whereby the accused persons were acquitted of the offences punishable under Sections 143, 147, 148 and 307 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4/25 of the Arms Act.
