The grievance of the petitioner is that the orders passed in Writ Petition No.1954/2001 are not complied with.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has filed pursis dated 7th January, 2021 stating therein that the Nagpur Municipal Corporation has suggested of granting of T.D.R. rights to the petitioner in respect of the acquired land and the same is acceptable to the petitioner.
