1. By this application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the applicants have challenged registration of the First Information Report bearing No.194/2017 dated 08.10.2017 for the offences punishable under Section 420 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. During pendency of the present application, the non-applicant No.1 has filed affidavit dated 10.02.2021.
