Matters in the aforesaid bunch have been put up for orders regarding dismissal against particular respondents, for which, copies for issuing notices are not supplied as yet. On failure to supply copies within three weeks, the matter would be dismissed against the particular respondents against whom copies are not supplied, in view of Chapter XVII Rule 7 (iii) of the Bombay High Court Appellate Side Rules, 1960, without further reference to the Court of Registrar (Judicial).
