PRAYER : Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 2nd respondent to dispose the appeal dated 25.09.2020 filed under Section 10 of Patta Passbook Act against the entries in Joint Patta in respect of land having extent of 3.79 cents comprised in Survey No.517/1A and Survey No.517/1B having extent of 3.57 cents situated at Kizhunjur

Village, Vellore Taluk, Vellore District within a time frame limited by affording a pre-decisional personal hearing for the petitioner.

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking a direction directing the 2nd respondent to dispose the appeal filed by the petitioner under Section 10 of Patta Passbook Act.

2. The grievance of the petitioner is that against the order passed by the Tahsildar cancelling the patta, the petitioner has preferred the appeal before the 2nd respondent on 25.09.2020, but so far, the appeal was not disposed of. Hence, the present Writ Petition has been filed by the petitioner.

3. I have heard and considered the submissions made by learned counsel appearing for petitioner as well as learned Addl. Government Pleader and perused the records carefully.

4. Considering the limited prayer sought in the Writ Petition, without going into the merits of the case, the 2nd respondent is directed to consider the petitioner's appeal and to pass suitable orders on merits after giving opportunity to the petitioner as well as to the rival claimants within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. Accordingly, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.

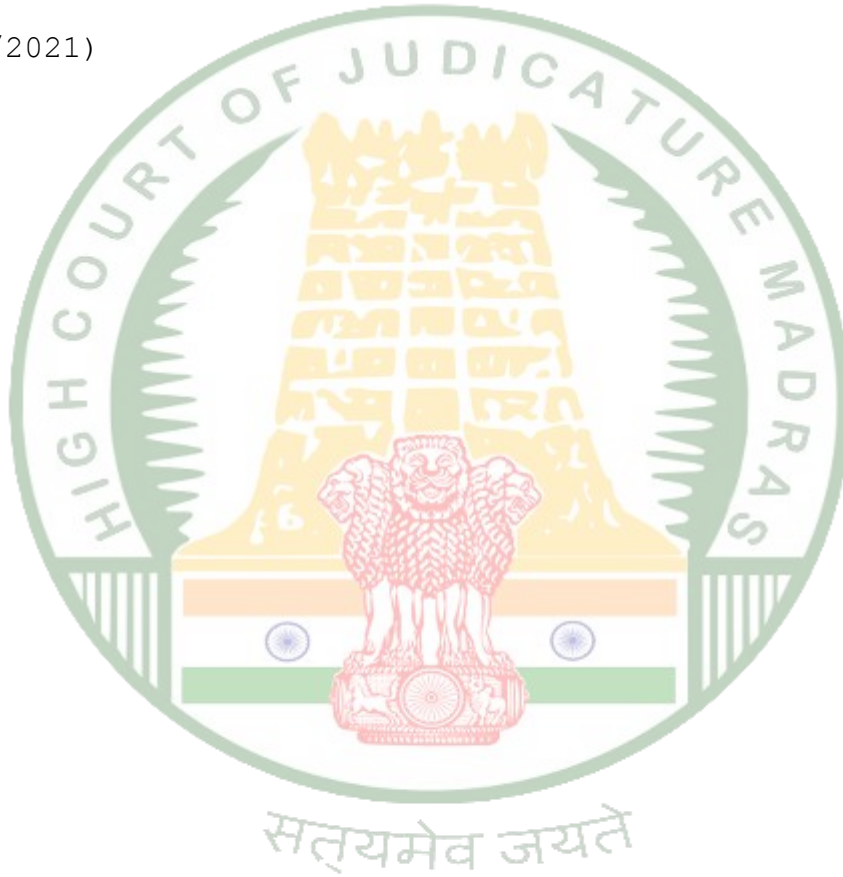
