3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the State submitted that the petitioner is regularly complying with the conditions imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.4936 of 2020 in Crl.O.P.No.4953 of 2020, dated 19.08.2020.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the condition already imposed on the petitioner in Crl.M.P.No.4936 of 2020 in Crl.O.P.No.4953 of 2020, dated 19.08.2020 is relaxed, however the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

5. This petition is ordered accordingly.
