ORDER

This Civil Revision Petition is filed seeking direction to the learned V Assistant Judge, City Civil Court, Chennai, to dispose of the case in O.S.No.3270 of 2013 on the file of the learned V Assistant City Civil Court,

Chennai, within a time period stipulated by this court.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the suit was filed by the respondents for the relief of permanent injunction. The examination of witnesses is over and the case is pending for arguments. However, the respondents dragging their proceedings without submitting their arguments. Therefore, the present Civil Revision Petition is preferred.

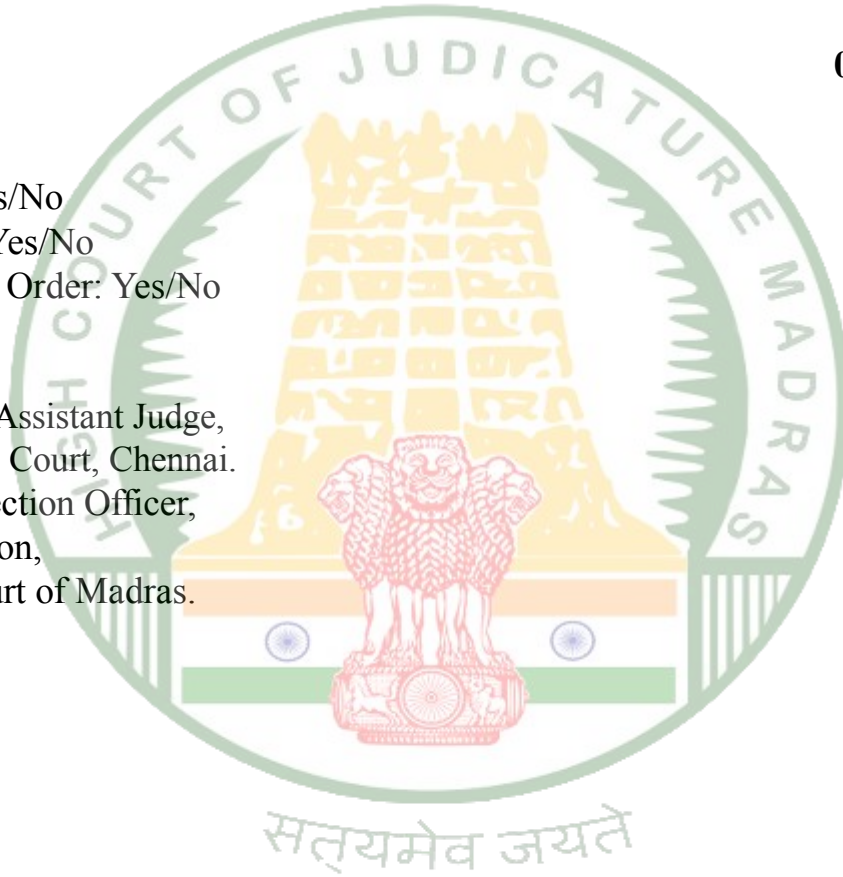
5. With the above direction, this Civil Revision Petition is disposed of. No costs.
