2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been regularly complying with the conditions.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the offence was committed against a woman and charge sheet has not yet been filed.

4. Considering the fact that charge sheet has not been filed and also considering the nature of offence, this Court is not

inclined to relax the condition. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed. The petitioner is directed to comply with the same condition.
