Side) would submit that on the complaint given by the petitioner, on 28.11.2011 the case in Crime No.328 of 2011 was registered by the respondent for offence under Section 323, 324 and 294(b) IPC. was filed before the Judicial Magistrate, Chengam, during the year 2017. However, the learned Magistrate has rejected the final report under Section 468 Cr.P.C. stating that it is barred by limitation and there by the petition has become infructuous.

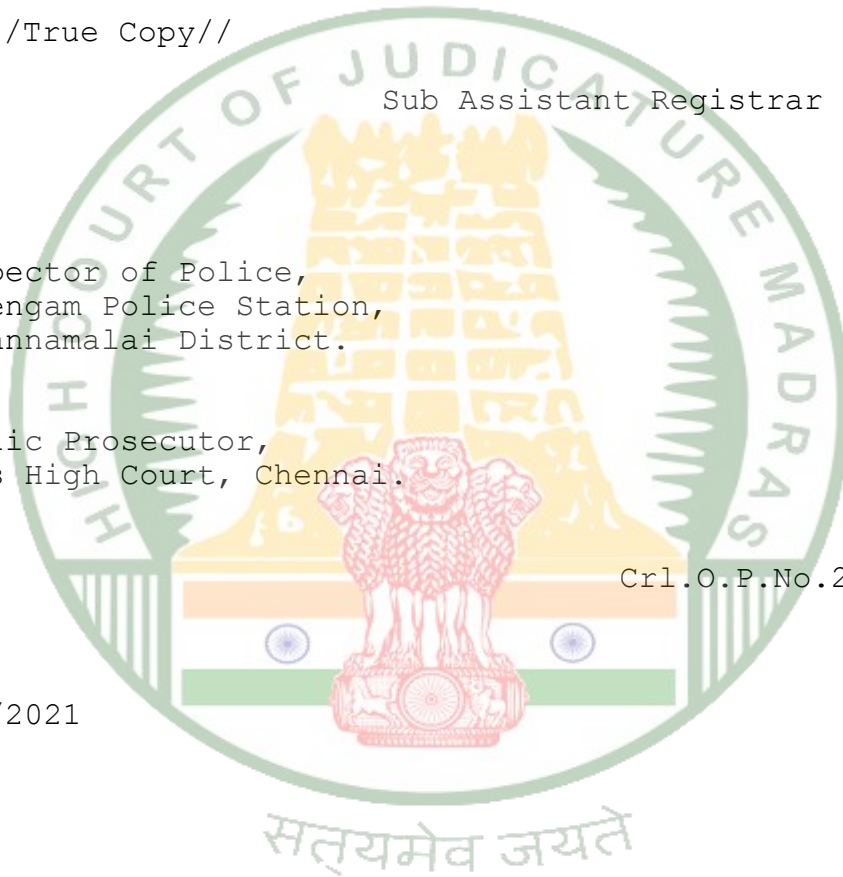
