3. Taking into consideration the fact that the nature of the dispute involved in this case is a matrimonial dispute, it is for the parties to redress the same before the appropriate Civil Court and the respondent police will have no role to play in a case of this nature.

4. This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent police not to interfere with the matrimony dispute and it is open for the parties to agitate their rights before the competent civil court.
