3.Registry is directed to take the appeal on file, if it is otherwise in order.

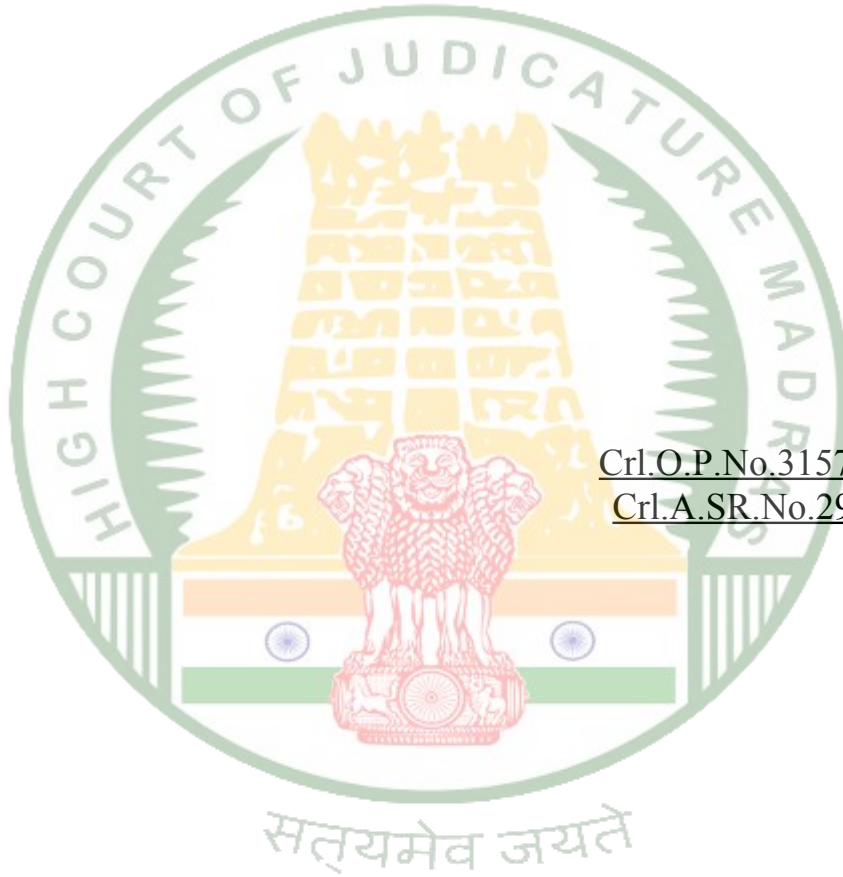
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
