

ii) That the appellant herein/insurance company be and hereby is directed to deposit the modified compensation amount of Rs.3,73,400/- together with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum as assessed by the Tribunal from the date of claim till the date of deposit, after deducting the amount already deposited if any to

the credit of MCOP.No.279 of 2012 within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment;

iii)That on such deposit being made, the Tribunal shall transfer the amount lying to the credit of MCOP.No.279 of 2012 to the bank account of the 1st respondent herein/claimant through RTGS within a period of one week thereafter;

iv)That the appellant herein/Insurance company shall be permitted to withdraw the excess amount lying in the credit of MCOP.No.279 of 2012, if the entire award amount has been already deposited by them before the Tribunal by filing an appropriate application;

V)That there be no costs in this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal;
