When the Petitioner has been imposed with the punishment of withholding of 100% monthly pension and gratuity permanently, the question of grant of provisional pension by way of interim relief does not arise. In case, the Petitioner succeeds in the Writ Petition, he will be entitled to 100% relief or such other relief, depending upon the order that may be passed by this Court.

4. In view of the same, this Miscellaneous Petition stands dismissed.

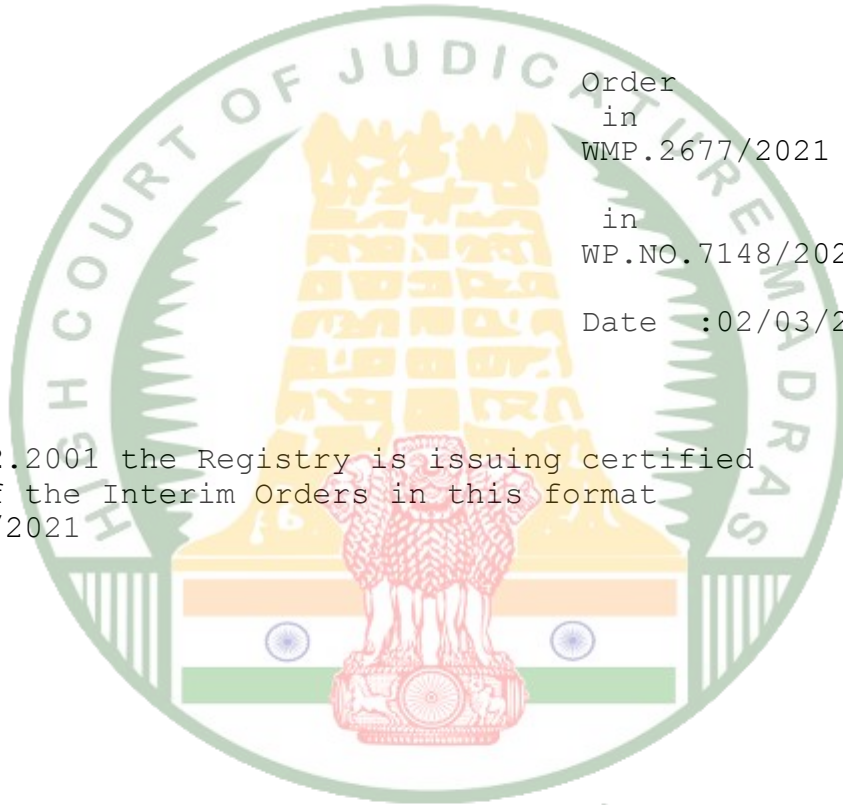
