Prayer : Petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India praying for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records of the 2nd respondent in Na.Ka.No.1082/05/E dated 17.04.2007 and the consequential order Na.Ka.No.1082/2005/E dated 25.04.2007 and quash the same and further direct the respondents to pay the subsistence allowance to the petitioner as per Fundamental Rules.

ORDER

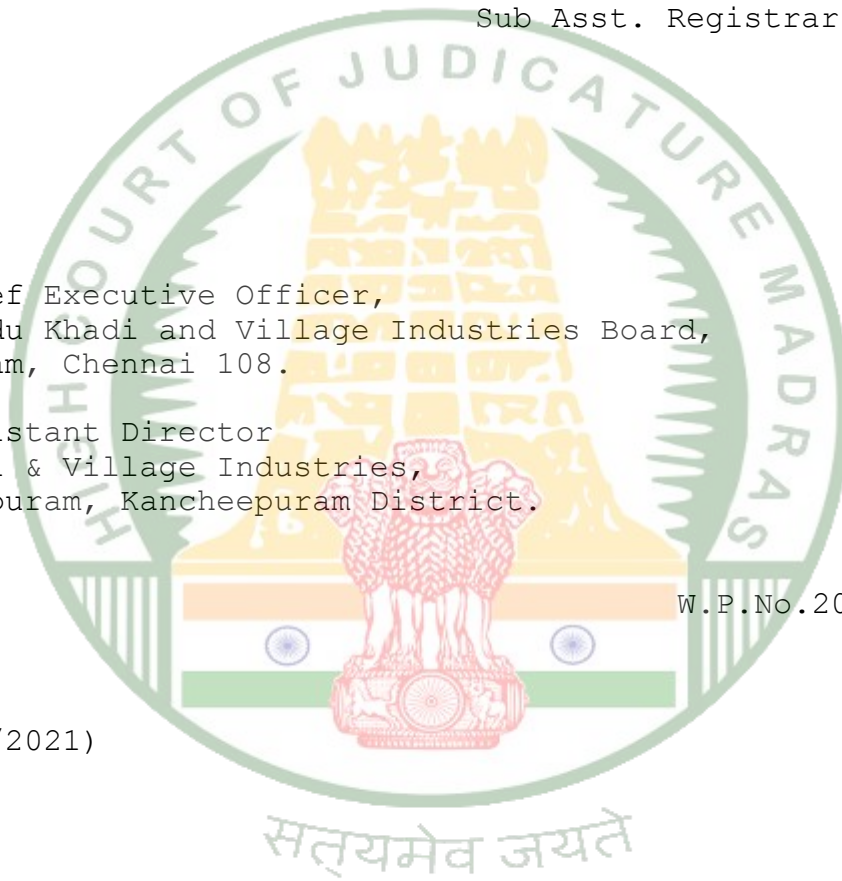
