O R D E R

This Writ Petition has been filed, seeking to quash the impugned notice dated 03.05.2004, bearing Circular No.3 of 2004, issued by the 2nd respondent, with a direction to the Respondents 1, 3 and 6 to take action on the illegal activities of the Respondents 2 and 7.

2. At the first blush, it is pertinent to mention here that the impugned notice was of the year 2004 and more than 16 years have gone-by. At this distant point of time, this Court is not inclined to go into the merits and demerits of the impugned notice and also its veracity. Moreover, the present Writ Petition is not maintainable, as the remedy lies to the petitioner before a different Forum.

3. In view of the above, finding no merits in the relief sought for, this Writ Petition is dismissed. No costs. Consequently connected miscellaneous petition are also closed.
