2. Read this in conjunction with and in continuation of earlier proceedings made in last five listings on 04.08.2021, 05.08.2021, 06.08.2021, 10.08.2021 and 12.08.2021 which read as follows:

Proceedings dated 04.08.2021:

'There is no representation for the writ petitioner though name of writ petitioner and writ petitioner's counsel are duly shown in the cause list.
