Recording the same, the writ petition is dismissed as

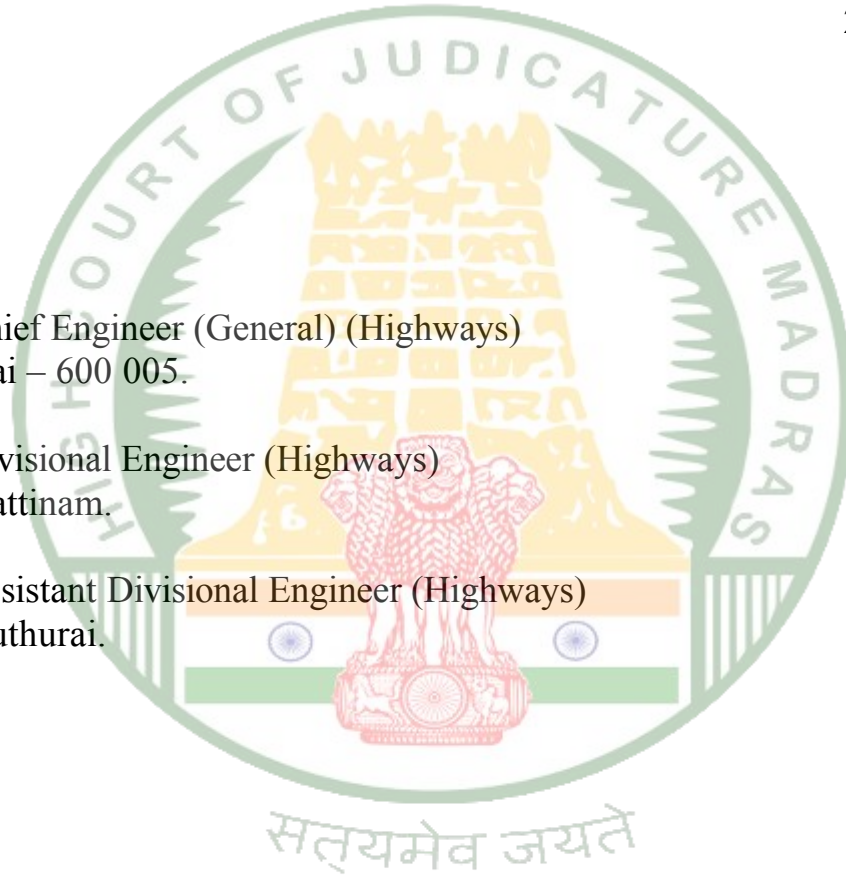
infructuous giving liberty to the petitioner to reopen it, if at all anything survives for further adjudication. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
