ii)that the Appellant herein/Insurance Company be and hereby is directed to deposit the compensation awarded by this tribunal along with interest at the rate of 7.5% p.a and costs from the date of Petition till the date of

deposit less the amount already deposited within a period of Six weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order;

iii)that on such deposit being made the Ist Respondent herein/Claimant be and hereby is permitted to withdraw the award amount, fixed by the Tribunal, along with interest and costs, after adjusting the amount, if any, already withdrawn, by filing a appropriate applications before the Tribunal.

vi)that there be no costs;
