4. The aforementioned trajectory brings to light that the writ petitioner is not interested in pursuing the captioned writ petition.

Captioned writ petition is dismissed for default/non-prosecution. Consequently, connected writ miscellaneous petition is also dismissed for default. There shall be no order as to costs.
