- 2.that the husband/appellant and wife/respondent both settled their dispute out of court and rejoined into their matrimonial life and living as husband and wife with their minor daughter happily from the past 5 months thereby presently the husband and wife are living



happily without any dispute and regret for the unpleasant happenings in our life. The husband and wife both are not interested in further proceedings of the cases pending before the Honourable Courts of law.

3. That the recording the above joint compromise memo dated 20.02.2021 the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of.

4. That there shall be no costs in this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.
