Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent authority to give permission to conduct cultural programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of Echampallam Village Arulmigu Sree Muniappan Temple Festival at Palakkodu Taluk, Dharmapuri District on 17.02.2021 between 6.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m. by considering the petitioner's representation dated 04.02.2021.

ORDER

Mr.K.Parameshwaran, learned Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

2. By consent of both the parties, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

3. This Writ Petition has been filed for a mandamus seeking for a direction to the respondent to give permission to conduct cultural programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) on the occasion of Echampallam Village Arulmigu Sree Muniappan Temple Festival at Palakkodu Taluk, Dharmapuri District on 17.02.2021 between 6.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m. by considering the petitioner's representation dated 04.02.2021.

4. According to the petitioner, he is the Secretary of the festival Committee of Arulmigu Sree Muniappan Temple Festival at Palakkodu Taluk, Dharmapuri District. According to him, for the past two decades, the temple has been conducting cultural programmes in a peaceful manner. According to the petitioner, the temple intends to conduct a cultural programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) at the aforementioned temple on 17.02.2021 between 06.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. The petitioner has given a representation to the respondent on 04.02.2021 seeking permission to conduct the cultural programme on 17.02.2021. Since the respondent has not considered the petitioner's representation, the petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

5. Heard Mr.A.Sathishkumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.K.Parameshwaran, learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent.

6. Mr.K.Parameshwaran, learned Government Advocate appearing on behalf of the respondent, on instructions, would submit that the respondent is willing to permit the petitioner to conduct the cultural programme subject to fulfillment of certain stringent conditions that have been imposed by this Court time and again. He would further submit the cultural programme to be conducted by the petitioner should end by 10.00 p.m and cannot continue beyond the said time. For this submission, the learned counsel for the petitioner agrees.

7. For the foregoing reasons, this Court directs the respondent to grant permission to the petitioner to conduct cultural programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) on the occasion of Echampallam Village Arulmigu Sree Muniappan Temple Festival at Palakkodu Taluk, Dharmapuri District on 17.02.2021 between 06.00 p.m and 10.00 p.m.subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions by the petitioner.

(a) The cultural programme in connection with the event of festival of Echampallam Village Arulmigu Sree Muniappan Temple Festival at Palakkodu Taluk, Dharmapuri District shall be conducted on 17.02.2021 between 06.00 p.m and 10.00 p.m.

(b)The petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) as charges, to the respondent Police and on receipt of the same, the respondent Police is directed to issue receipt and proceed further.

(c) There should not be any kind of obscene dance or vulgar dialogues during the performance, by anyone of the participants.

(d) Double meaning songs should not be played so as to spoil the minds of students and youths.

(e) No dance or songs, touching upon any political party or religion or community or caste shall be played.

(f) No flex boards in support of any political party or communal leader, shall be erected at the premises of the programme.

(g) The function shall not affect either religious or communal harmony and shall be conducted without any discrimination based on caste.

(h) If there is violation of any one of the conditions imposed, the concerned police officer is at liberty to take necessary action, as per law and stop such performance forthwith; and

(i) Similarly, the police is directed to stop the dance programme, if it is played beyond the permitted time limit.

(j) The respondent is directed to issue necessary permission, incorporating the above conditions.

8. With the aforesaid direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

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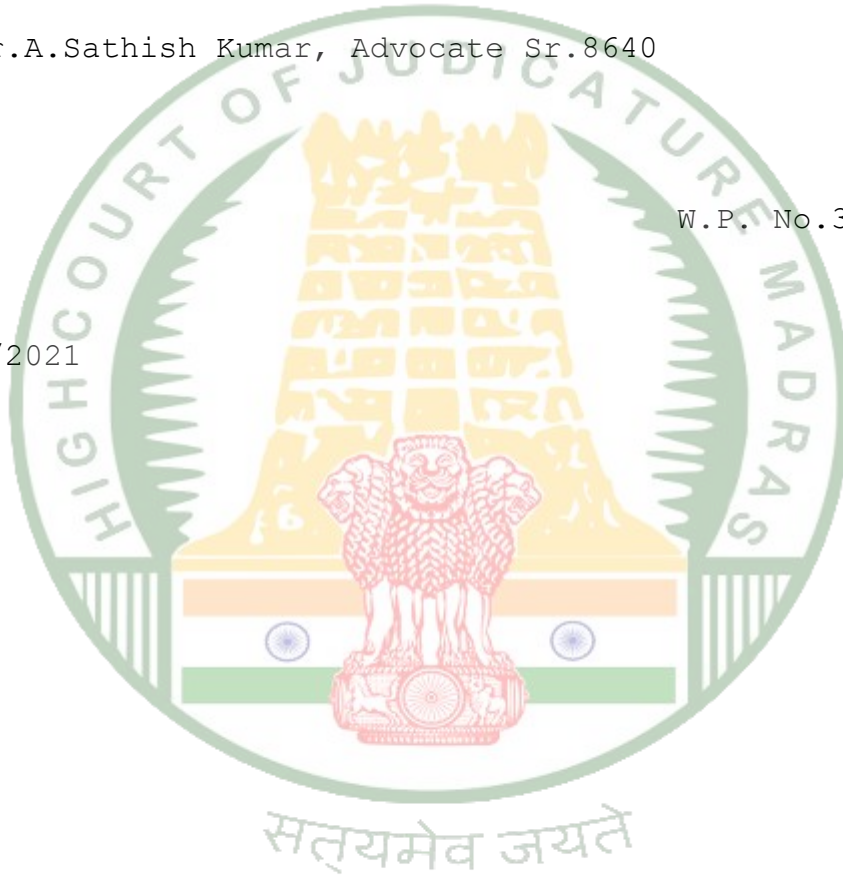
