PRAYER : Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records of the first Respondent in connection with the impugned orders passed by him in Na.Ka.No.15004/2009/Ku.Vi.3, dated 26.04.2010 and quash the same and direct the respondents to enroll the Petitioner as a member in the general provident fund scheme by taking into consideration the earlier service rendered by him in a public sector undertaking from 20.07.1987 to 21.07.2009 and grant him all consequential service and monetary benefits.

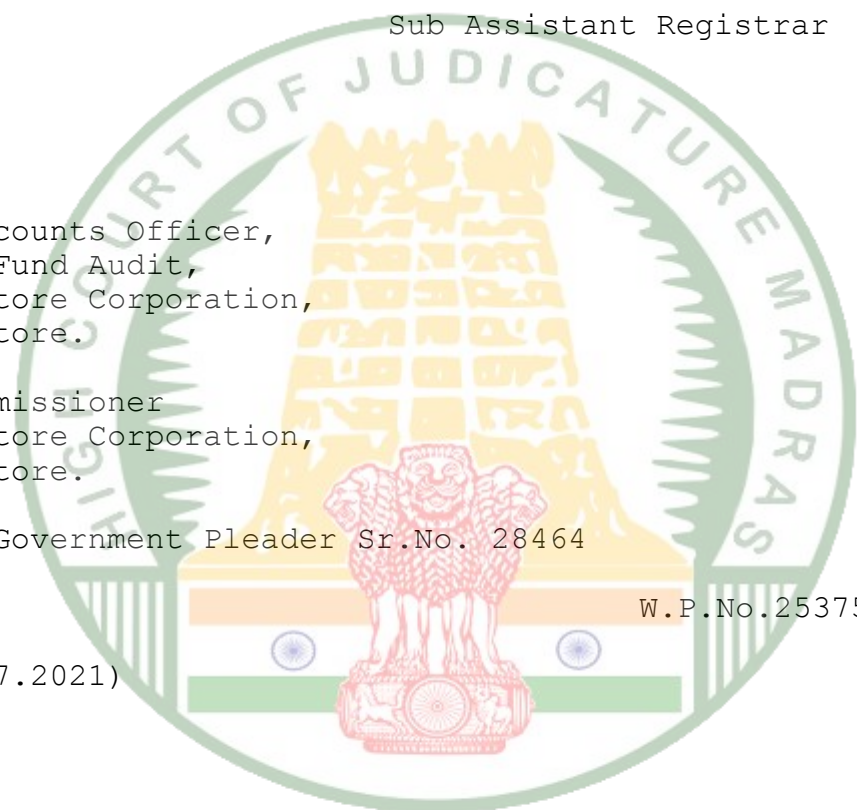
