ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to recall the non bailable warrant issued by the learned Judge, Fast Track Court II, Allikulam, in C.C.No.6646 of 2018.

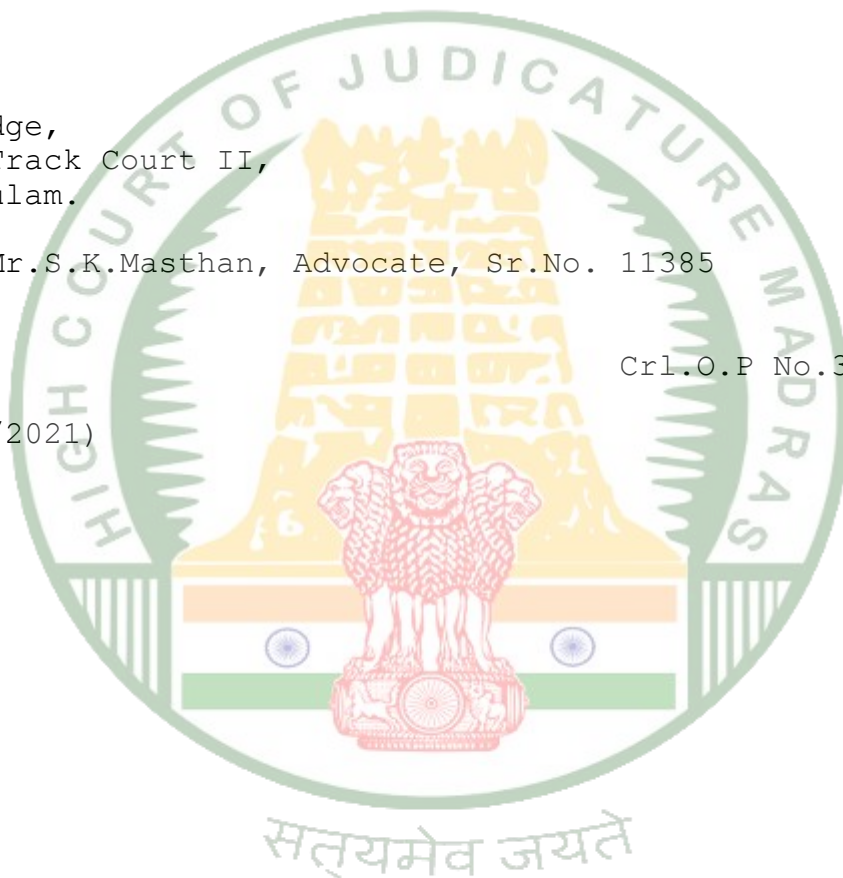
