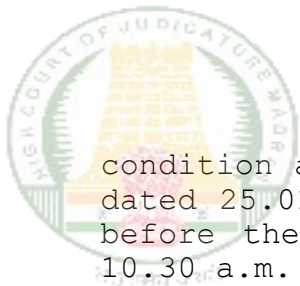
(This case has been heard through video conference)
