Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Declaration to declare the entire selection process followed by the first respondent for selection of candidates for Group-II posts, both interview posts and non-interview posts, by conducting CSSE-I examinations for the year 2009-2011 by the first respondent pursuant to the Advertisement nos.258 dated 30.12.2010, 265 dated 08.02.2011 and 280 dated 11.06.2011 as illegal, void and unconstitutional and consequently direct the first respondent to start the selection process afresh following the relevant rules scrupulously in a transparent manner.
