O R D E R

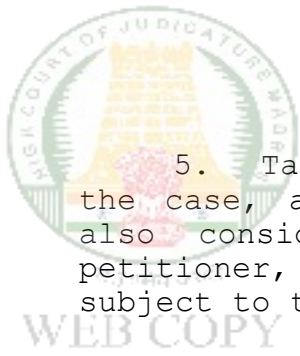

The Petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 09.01.2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 353, 294(A), 307 of IPC r/w. 5, 7(3) of L.R. Act in Crime No.26 of 2021, seeks bail.

2. The petitioner is the sole accused. The case of the prosecution is that on 09.01.2021, on patrol, when the respondent police tried to arrest the petitioner, who was illegally selling the banned lotteries, the petitioner said to have abused the police people and also attacked them. Hence, a complaint came to be registered.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. Admittedly, no one was injured in this case. Hence, he prays for grant of bail.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit that the petitioner is a notorious rowdy element and he is involved in 9 previous cases. On the date of occurrence, when the police party tried to arrest the petitioner and seize the banned lottery tickets from the petitioner, he abused the police persons and also attacked them. Now, investigation is almost completed. Hence, she opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.



5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstance of the case, and the fact that investigation is almost completed and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

(a) Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ulundhurpet, and on further conditions that:

(b) the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the learned Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity;

(c) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

(d) the petitioner shall not commit any offences of similar nature;

(e) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(f) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(g) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560];

(h) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.

6. With the above directions, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered.
