4. Being satisfied with the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit filed in support of the petition, the condone delay petition is ordered.

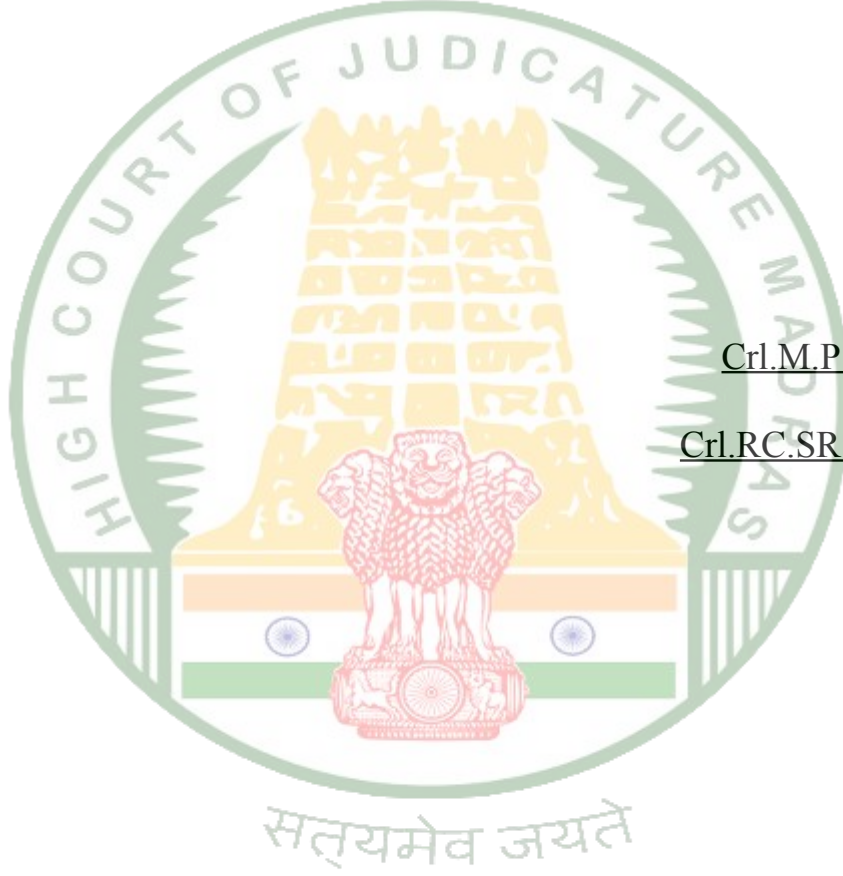
5. The Registry is directed to number the above Criminal Revision Case, if the papers are otherwise in order .
