Both sides counsel appeared through video conferencing.

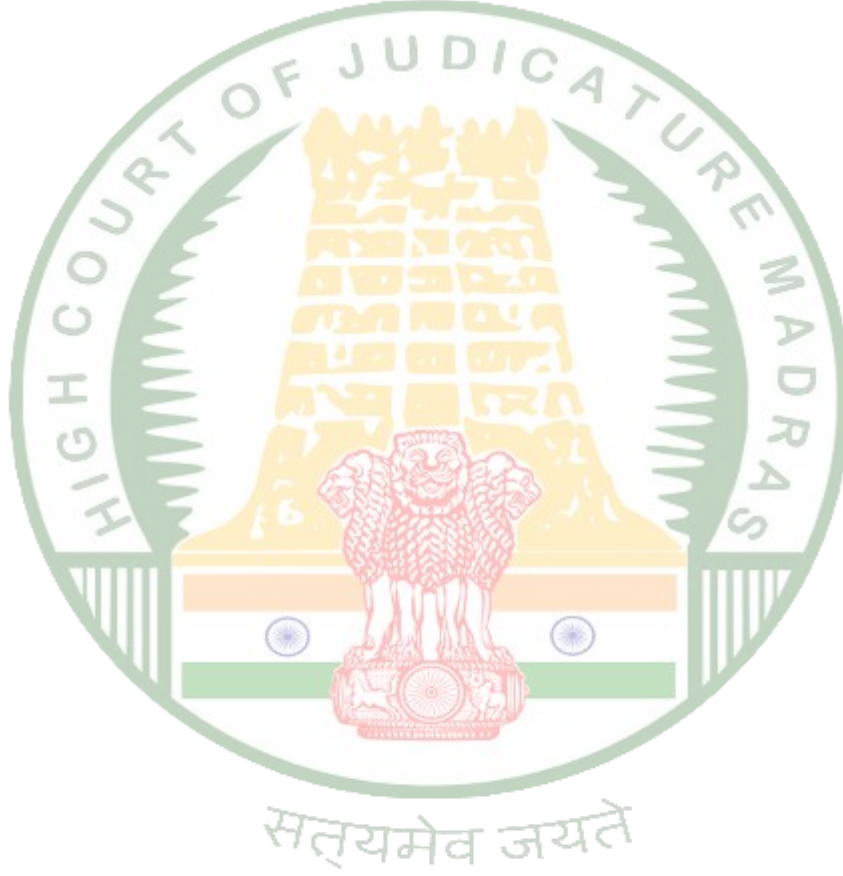

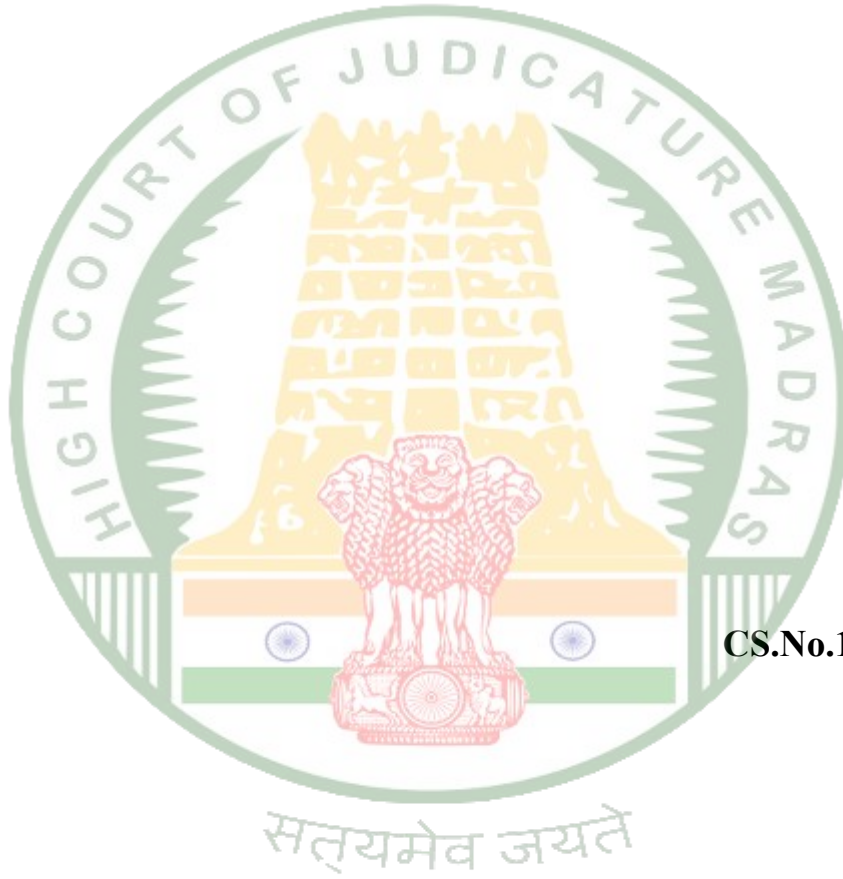
