2. Even today, the plaintiff has not served copy of the plaint to the learned counsel for the defendant. In these pandemic days, this Court is not inclined

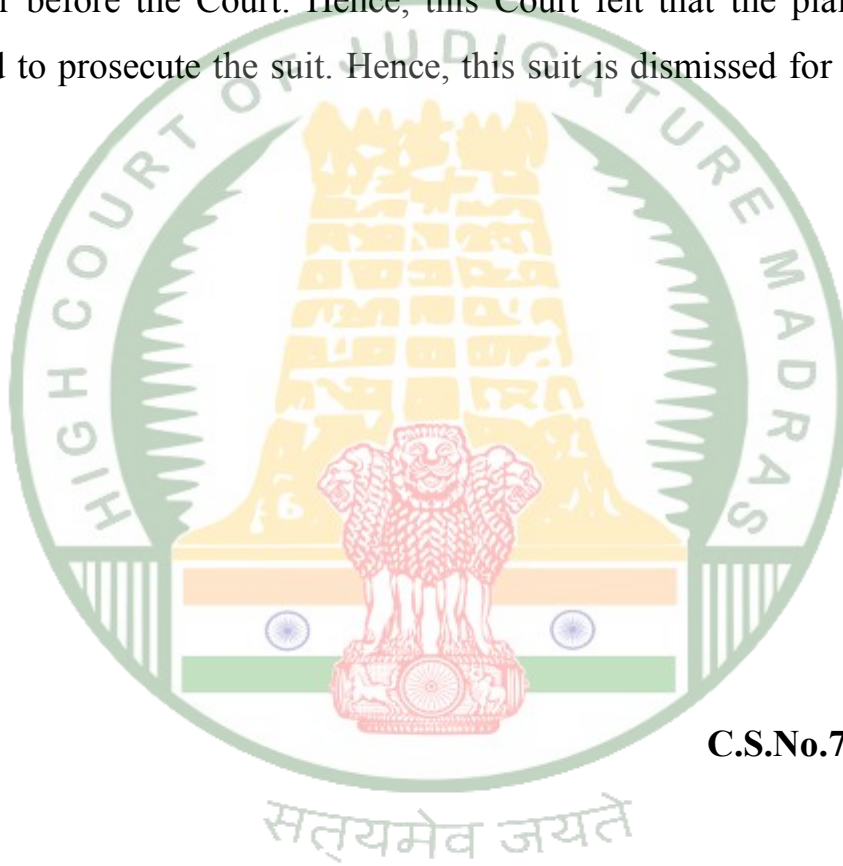
