i)that the compensation of Rs.31,02,303/-(Rs.Thirty One Lakhs Two Thousand Three Hundred and Three Only) together with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till the date of deposit be and hereby is confirmed.

ii)that the Appellant herein/Insurance Company be and hereby is directed to deposit the award amount, along with interest and costs, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment, to the credit of M.C.O.P. No.102 of



2018.

iii)that on such deposit being made, the respondents 1 and 2 be and hereby are permitted to withdraw their share of the award amount, determined by the Tribunal, along with proportionate interest and costs, as per the ratio of apportionment fixed by the Tribunal, after adjusting the amount, if any, already withdrawn, by filing necessary applications before the Tribunal.

iv)that the appeal be and hereby is dismissed as against the 3rd respondent herein.

v)that there be no costs in this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.
