No.6545/EDS2/2012 dated 14.10.2014 and the consequential order of the first respondent issued in Letter No.5223/E1 (2)/2015-6 dated 18.02.2016 and quash the said orders and direct the Respondents 1 to 3 to re-draw the seniority list of Chemists reckoning the Notification No.37/2012 dated 07.09.2012 issued by the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, Chennai, for direct recruitment to the post of Chemist as the date for fixing the Petitioner's seniority as per rule 2(14) of the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules and fix his seniority over and above the Respondents 4 to 6 herein.
