Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of MR.Y.ANILKUMAR AND R.MUKUNDAN, Advocate for the petitioner and of MR.VASUDHA THIAGARAJAN, ADVOCATE on behalf of the Respondents the court made the following order:-

Both the petitioner and the first respondent have filed their respective appeals against the judgment and decree of the trial court. The trial Court has awarded a sum of Rs.5 lakhs with 12% interest payable by the petitioner.

2.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant the order of stay pending disposal of the appeal. Accordingly, there shall be an order of interim stay pending disposal of the appeal on condition that the petitioner pays 50% of the damages awarded by the trial Court along with interest as ordered by the trial Court within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

This miscellaneous petition is disposed of accordingly.
