This writ petition has been filed challenging the order, dated 5/2/2020, passed by the third respondent, rejecting the petitioner's request for extension of time in making the balance payment of Rs.24,25,000/- under e-auction conducted by the fifth respondent.

2. Heard Mr.A.Arokhiaraj, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.K.Parameshwaran, learned Government Advocate for the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions would submit that subsequent to the filing of the writ petition, fifth respondent has granted extension of time to the petitioner to make balance payment of Rs.24,25,000/-, on 16/10/2020. Since the extension of time has been granted, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no necessity for this Court to pass any further orders.

4. Recording the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, instant writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.

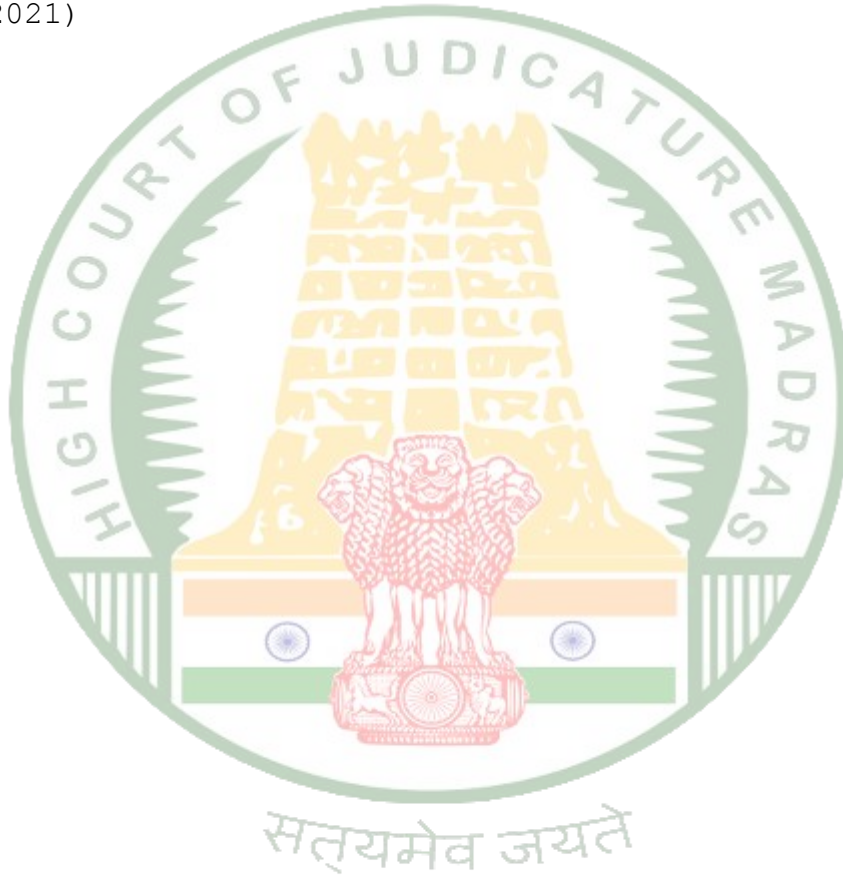
