ORDER

3.The said statement of the learned Special Government Pleader is recorded.

4.In view of the above, no further direction is required to be given except that the respondent is directed to issue notice to all the parties who are likely to be affected by his decision, provide them a fair and effective hearing and to dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 09.03.2020 through a speaking order within a period of eight (8) weeks after excluding such time that may be lost to the Tahsildar during the counting procedure of the General Election of the Tamil Nadu

State Legislative Assembly, 2021, which is scheduled to take place on 02.05.2021.

5.The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.

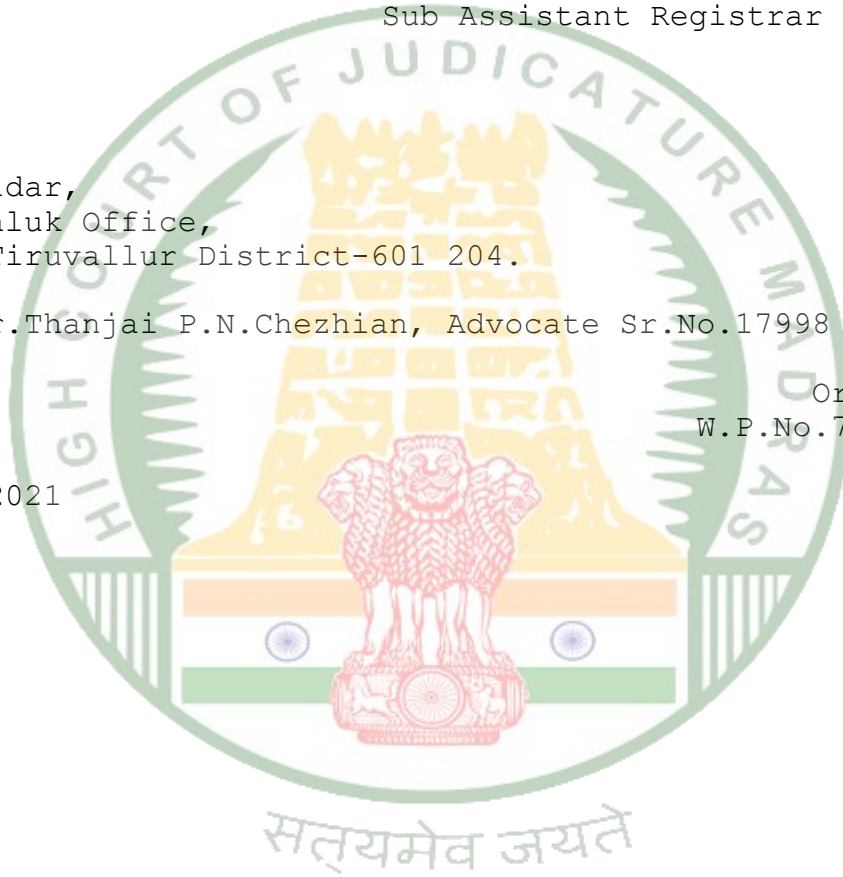
