This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking to quash the F.I.R in Crime No.164 of 2020, on the file of the respondent.

2.The facts of this case is covered by the reported Judgments of this Court in Jeevanandham and others Vs. State Rep. by Inspector of Police and another reported in (2018) 2 LW Cr1 606 and Sri Raja Vs. State Rep. By Inspector of Police, Sivakasi Town Police Station, Virudhunagar District, and another reported in (2019) 2 LW Cr1 350.

3. In the Considered view of this Court, no offence has been made out against the petitioner. That apart, it is brought to the notice of this Court that the Government has taken a policy decision that all the cases that were registered against those who indulged in protest against the amendment to

Citizenship Act, is going to be withdrawn by the State. In view of the above, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the FIR pending in Crime No.164 of 2020, on the file of the respondent and the same is hereby quashed.

4.This Criminal Original Petition is accordingly allowed. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

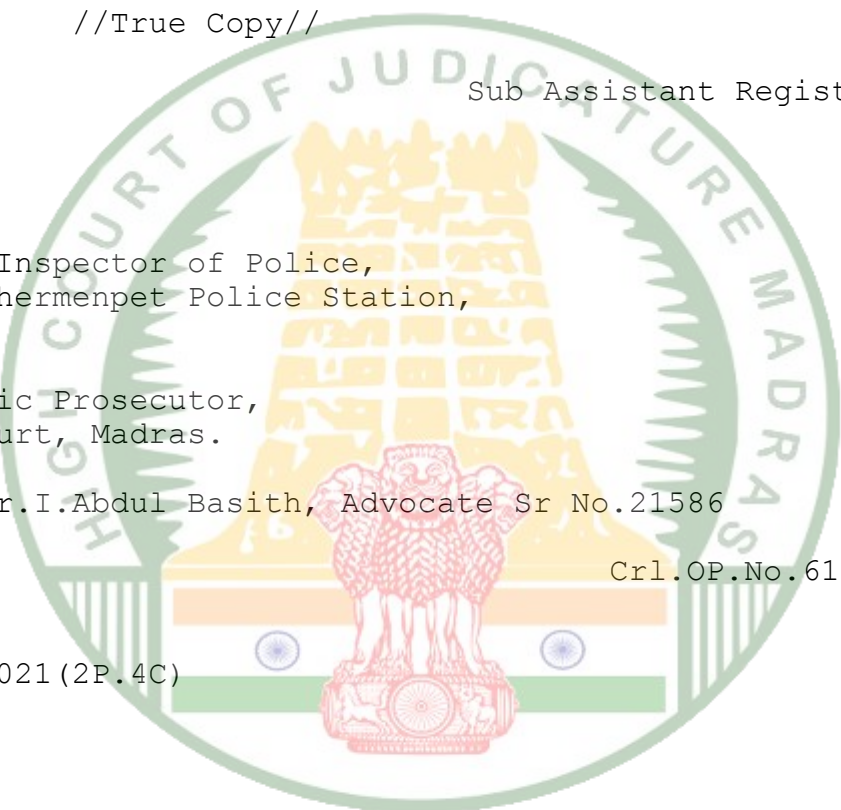
