COMMON ORDER

These Civil Revision Petitions have been filed against the fair and decreetal order dated 18.12.2017 made in I.A.Nos.11572 & 11573 of 2017 in O.S.No.6869 of 2013 on the file of the XII Assistant Judge, City Civil Court, Chennai.

2. When the matter was posted for admission on 10.07.2018 at the request of the learned counsel for the petitioner, it was adjourned. Even on that day, this Court directed the Trial Court to proceed with the suit in accordance with law without waiting for the order to be passed in the present Civil Revision Petitions. Today, when the matter was listed under the caption for "adjourned admission", the learned counsel for the petitioner again sought for adjournment.

3. In view of the above, it clearly shows that the learned counsel for the petitioner has no interest in proceeding with the case further. Further, these Civil Revision Petitions are pending for the past three years, without even admitting the same or ordering notice. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to entertain these petitions. Accordingly, these Civil Revision Petitions are dismissed. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.

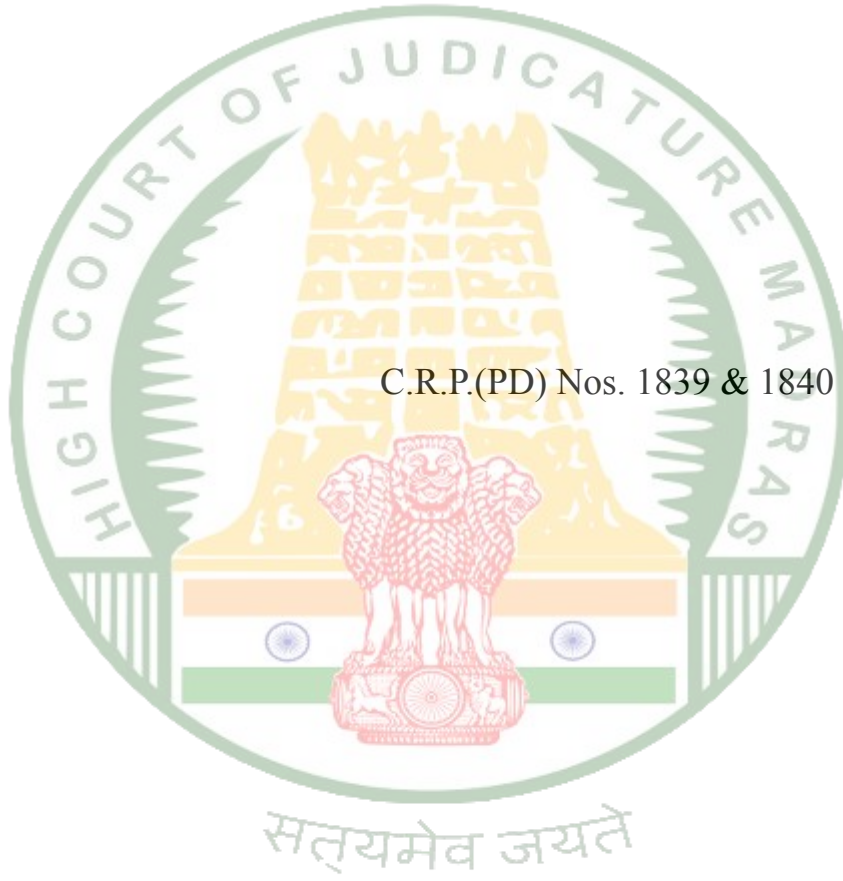
