Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, after calling for concerned records relating to order No.F.No.RO/OPS dated 27.10.2011 passed by the first respondent and quash the same and consequently, direct the respondents to sanction Rs.10 lakhs to the petitioner's daughter towards Educational Loan.

The order dated 27.10.2011 stating that the respondent-Bank may not consider the loan for the student, who got the admission under the Management Quota and the Residual Value of the Housing Loan property cannot be taken as a security, is under challenge in the present writ petition.
